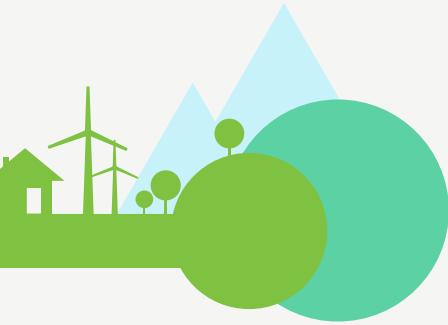

AEEE's vision is to enable an energy-efficient India.

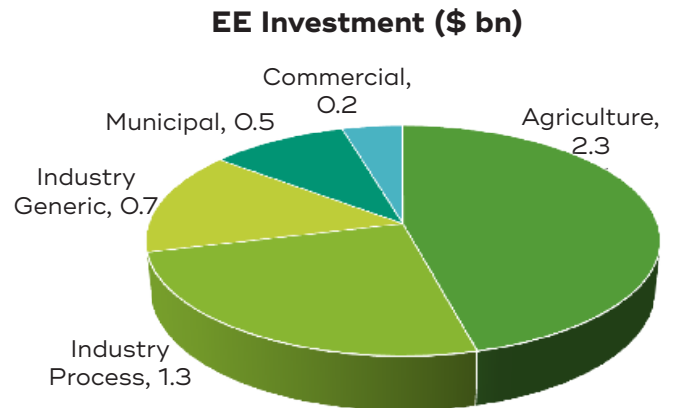

Formed a coalition of 12 key organisations to promote the adoption of lean, mean and green space cooling strategies to meet India's thermal comfort needs

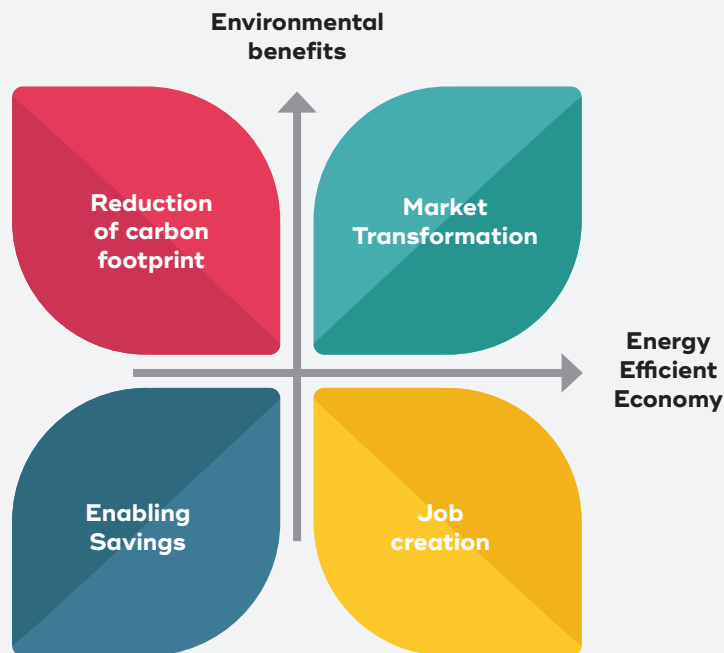

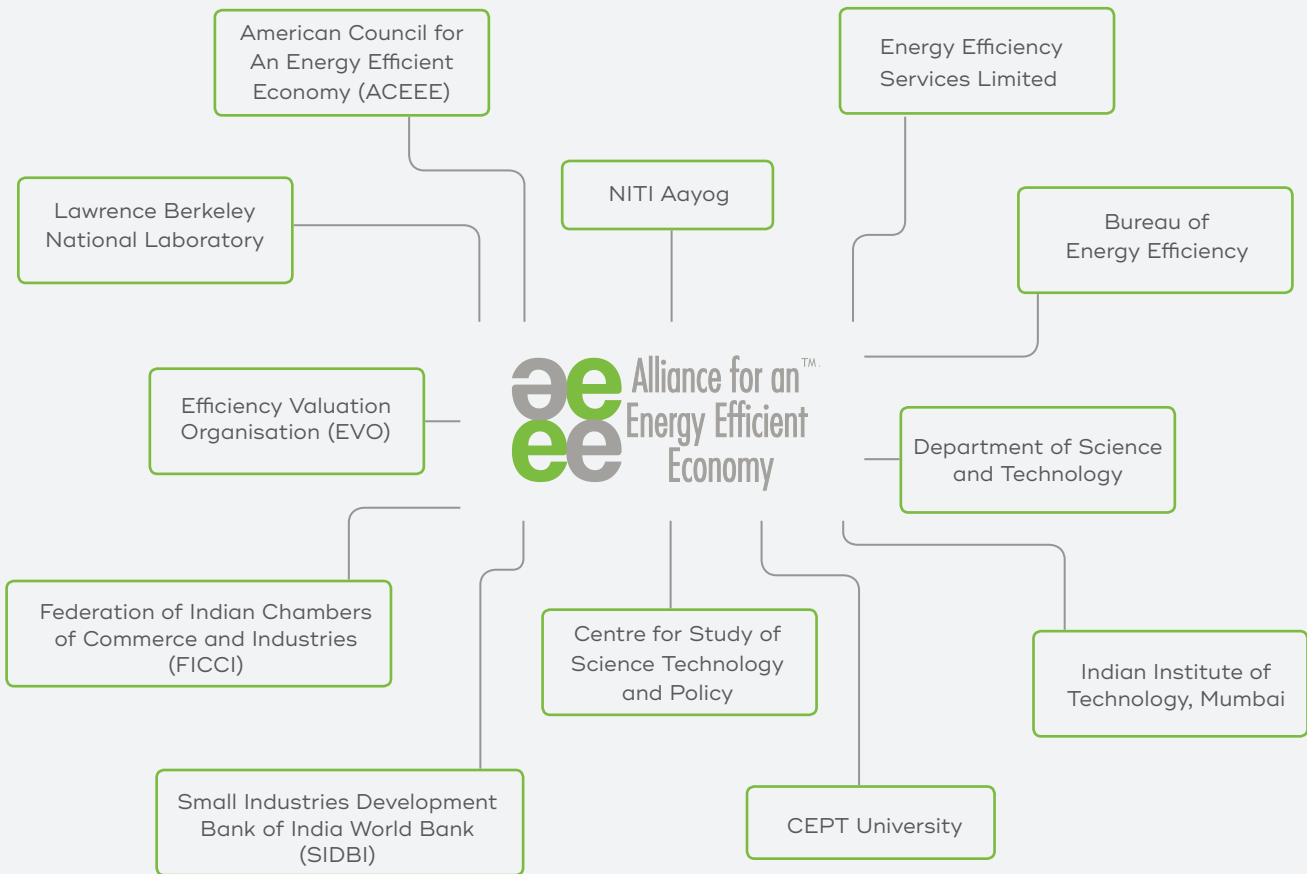
